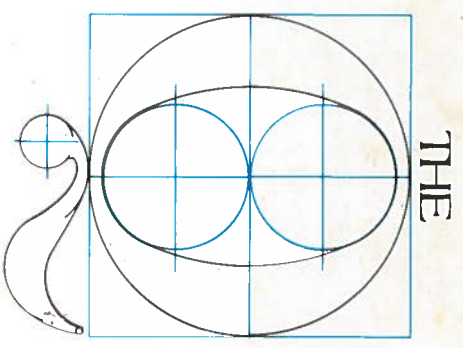

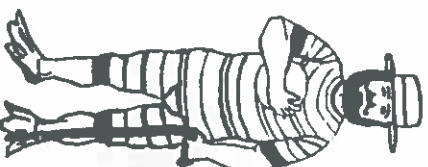

## RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT

The tournament schedule is extremely tight. Missed games will be played after the last game, or at Wanderers in the afternoon.

Players must be over thirty (30) years of age, and not be playing representative waterpolo at provincial level.

A handicap of one goal per two years difference in average age of teams will be applied.

During the Round Robin section of the Tournament (Friday and Saturday), play shall consist of two periods of 10 minutes each, with a break of one minute.

During the Playoff section (Sunday), play shall consist of two periods of 12 minutes each, with a break of one minute.

In the event of a tie in the Round Robin section, each team shall be awarded one point.

In the event of a tie in the Playoff section, the result shall be decided by penalties. Each team to have three penalty attempts. If after three penalties, a tie still exists, each team will have alternating penalty attempts on a "sudden death" basis.

At the completion of the Round Robin, should two or more teams have the same points score within a section, positions will be decided by goal average - ie "goals for" divided by "goals against".
