RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT

1. Over 30 years of age at date of tournament.
2. Over 40 years of age at date of tournament.
3. Over 50 years of age at date of tournament.
4. Handicapping based on Avg age of seven youngest members of the team.
5. One goal for every two years difference in Avg age subject to a maximum of three goals.
6. Avg age is round up or down - for example, 1,2 becomes 1 and 1,5 becomes 2.
7. In each age group players over their groupings age may play down, but players under their specified age group may not play up, provided the Avg age of seven youngest members is still over their groups entered age group. For example, in a team entered in the 40 + group: this team can have three players of 39 years and four players of 40 years and they will be eligible to play in the over 40's category.
8. Current International or Provincial "A" players are eligible only for the over 30's category no matter what their age is.
9. Dispensations may be permitted in breach of above, provided written representation is made to the Tournament Committee and permission received, prior to the Tournament.
10. The tournament schedule is extremely tight. Missed games will be played after the last game.
11. All games, including Round Robin, Playoff Sections and Finals, will consist of two chukkas of ten minutes each, with a break of 1 ½ minutes in between.
12. In the even of a tie in the Round Robin sections, each team will be awarded one point.
13. At the completion of the Round Robin, should two or more teams have the same points score within a section, position will be decided by goal Avg - i.e. "goals for" divided by "goals against".
14. In the event of a tie in the Playoff/Final Section, the result will be decided by penalties. Each team to have three penalty attempts. If after three penalties, a tie still exists, each team will have alternating penalty attempts on a "sudden death" basis.

TOURNAMENT

The Tournament will be played in the following three sections:

- Over 30
- Over 40
- Over 50

POOLS: Within these three groupings there will be two pools.

NUMBER OF GAMES: Each team will play every other team in their pool, with one extra game on Sunday, giving seven matches for each team for the tournament.

MATCH DURATION: Two chukkas of ten minutes each, with one minute to change ends.

HANDICAP: The handicap will be one goal for ever two complete years in difference in the Avg age of the youngest seven players in the team. A maximum of three goals applies. For example, Team A: Avg = 38, Team B: Avg = 40,6 therefore NO handicap

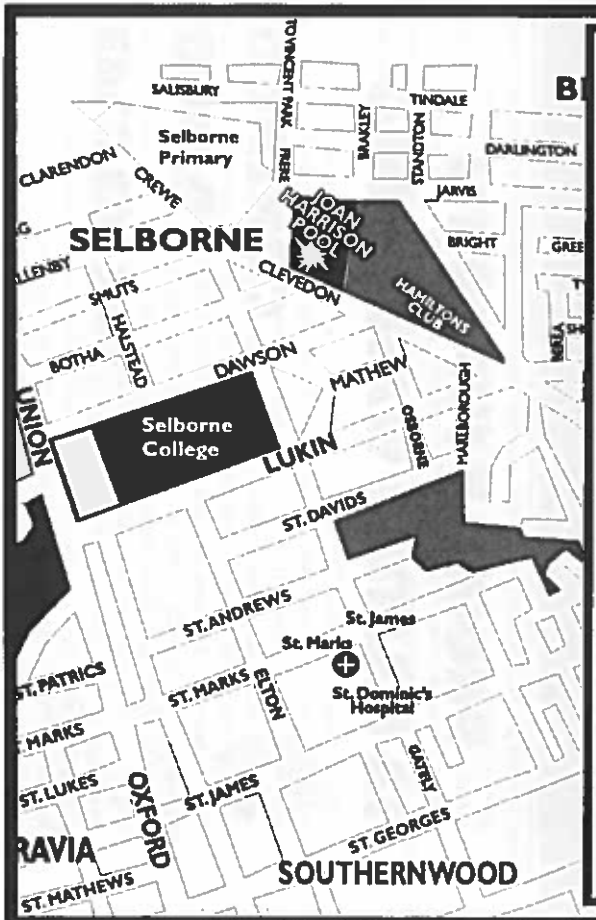

THE HISTORY OF WATER POLO

Water polo originated as a team sport as a demonstration of strength and swimming skill in late 19th century in England and Scotland. At these venues and at country fairs and festivals, water sports and racing exhibitions were a regular feature. Men's water polo was among the first team sports introduced at the modern Olympic games in 1900. Water polo is now popular in many countries around the world, notably Europe (particularly in Hungary, Greece, Italy, Russia and the former Yugoslavia), the United States, Canada and Australia. The present-day games involves teams of seven players (plus up to six substitutes), with a water polo ball similar in size to a soccer ball but constructed of water proof nylon.

The rules of water polo were originally developed in the late 19th century in Great Britain by William Wilson. The modern game originated as a form of rugby football played in rivers and lakes in England and Scotland with a ball constructed of Indian rubber. This "water rugby" came to be called "water polo" based on the English pronunciation of the Balti word for ball, "puld". Early play allowed brute strength, wrestling and holding opposing players underwater to recover the ball; the goalie stood outside the playing area and defended the goal by jumping in on any opponent attempting to score by placing the ball on the deck. By the 18880s, the game evolved to include fast-paced team play with a soccer-sized ball that emphasized swimming, passing, and scoring by shooting into a goal net; players could only be tackled when holding the ball and could not be taken under water. To deal with variations in regional rules, in 1888, the London Water Polo League was founded and approved a set of rules to allow team competition, forming the basis of the present game. The first English championships were played in 1888. In 189-, the first international water polo game was played; Scotland beat England, 4-0.

Between 1890 and 1900, the game developed in Europe, with teams competing in Germany, Austria, France, Belgium, Hungary and Italy, using British rules. A different game was being played in the United States, characterised by rough play, holding, diving underwater and soft-semi-inflated ball that could be gripped tightly and carried underwater. As a result, European teams did not complete in the 1904 Olympic championships in St. Louis. By 1914, most US teams agreed to conform to international rules. An international water polo committee was formed in 1929, consisting of representatives from Great Britain and the International Amateur Swimming Federation (FINA). Rules were developed for international matches and put into effect in 1930; FINA has been the international governing body for the sport since that time.

Over the years, both technical and rule changes affected the character of the game. In 1928, Hungarian water polo coach Bela Komjadi invented the "air pass" or "dry pass", a technique in which a player directly passes the ball through the air to another player, who receives it without the ball hitting the water. Previously, players would let the ball drop in the water first and then reach out for it, but the dry pass made the offensive game more dynamic, and contributed to Hungarian dominance of water polo for 60 years. In 1936, James R (Jimmy) Smith, California water polo coach and author of several books on water polo mechanics, developed a water polo ball made with an inflatable bladder and a rubber fabric cover, which improved performance. The previous leather ball absorbed water and became heavier during the game. In 1949, rule changes allowed play to continue uninterrupted after a referee whistled an ordinary foul, speeding up play. In the 1970's, the exclusion foul replaced a point system for major fouls; players guilty of this foul were excluded for a 1 minute penalty and their team forced to play with fewer players. Possession of the ball was limited to 45 seconds before a scoring attempt. Time of penalties and possession has been reduced since then. The direct shot on goal from the seven metre line after a free throw was allowed in 1994 and changed to a five metre throw in 2005.

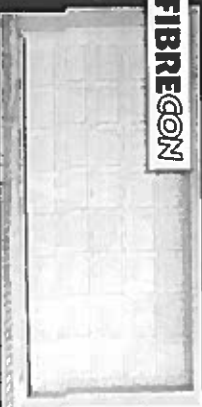
