



### Information – Masters 2020

#### General:

- Registration from 5pm on Wed at the players' area next to the pool.
- AGM members to meet at 5:30/6pm on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> March.
- 2020 Masters Welcome will start at 7:30pm – please come join for a beer and see the venue. Food will also be available if you looking for some dinner.

#### Drinks:
