1. <u>WELCOME</u>

1.1 The Chairman, Mr Neville Clarence, welcomed all persons attending the Annual General Meeting.

5. <u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u>

- 8.1.2 All information pertaining to SA Masters Waterpolo is available from this website.

8.2 <u>25 year awards</u>

- 8.2.1 A new award has been introduced to recognise any player/coach who has attended 25consecutive SA Masters Waterpolo tournaments.
- 8.2.2 All in attendance were in agreement with this new award being instituted.
- 8.3 <u>Future year costumes</u>
- 8.3.1 These would be determined and addressed closer to the time.
- 8.4 <u>Length of the Tournament</u>
- 8.4.1 Rob Rowles (Eastern Province) stated that the tournament was now becoming too long. The basic ideals were good but some teams are faced with high costs and few games.
- 8.4.2 Brett Redelinghuis (Western Province) was trying the 7s-rugby format of Cup, Plate, Bowl and Shield finals instead of play-offs for 1&2, 3&4, 5&6 and 7&8 places. Neville Davies (Western Province) stated that it was more oriented towards the younger players and that the older players were OK by any format.
- 8.4.3 Neville Clarence reminded all that the basic premises should be league/round-robin games for the first two days, with either 1 or 2 games per team on the last day.
- 8.4.4 The current duration (Thu, Fri, Sat) is working where the tournament ends on the Saturday because in the past some teams did not pitch for their Sunday fixtures leaving their opponents without a game on the last day.
- 8.4.5 The 2014 organisers are to take these points into consideration when planning next year's event.

- 8.7.1 Minimum age to participate in the SA Masters Waterpolo tournament
 - The minimum age for all players is twenty-five (25) years unless the player is a current or recent international player then the age limit will be thirty (30) years.
- 8.7.2 The general consensus was that younger players may partake in the tournament as long as their team's average age of the youngest seven was within the age groupings.
- 8.7.3 As to international players, the current status remains:
 - If the player is a current or recent international player then the age limit will be thirty (30) years.
- 8.8 <u>Current Trophy statuses</u>
- 8.8.1 Brett Redelinghuis (Western Province) is to reconcile and advise which trophies are missing as well as those trophies that have lost their titles.
