- 4.2 There being no matters arising acceptance was proposed by Mike Samuel of Natal and seconded by Mike Renwick of Gauteng.

- 5.2 Neville Clarence presented the treasurer's report.
- 5.3 The SA Masters Water Polo account has been frozen due to FICA rules.
- 5.4 Neville is busy resolving this with the bank.
- 5.5 The financials are sound.
- 5.6 Future expenses forecast are as follows:
 - Replacing another set of caps.
 - Acquisition of 20 year costumes

• Stock of the existing 10 year costumes is sufficient.

- 6.2 Updated details of provincial representatives are attached hereto.
- 6.3 Consideration is to be given to getting younger representation on to the representative level for all of the provinces. Masters was started nearly 20 years ago and has grown considerably. Each province to address youth recruitment in its own right.

7. SOUTH AFRICAN MASTERS WATER POLO CHAMPIONSHIPS 2007

- 7.1 SA Masters Water Polo has grown substantially over the last few years and this year's tournament in Knysna has attracted 42 teams.
- 7.2 After some discussion, it was suggested that the tournament be extended by at least an extra half day.
- 7.3 Two options were put forward:
- 7.3.1 Extend the tournament over an additional day, or
- 7.3.2 Increase the number of available pools.
- 7.3.3 It was suggested that whichever option is exercised would be at the discretion of the hosting province and would depend on the number of teams entered for that year.
- 7.4 Criteria for hosting SA Masters was again emphasised
 - At least three (3) pools at the same venue.
 - Current venues satisfying the above are Durban, Cape Town, East London & Knysna.
- 7.5 Neville Davies (Western Province) indicated that the Newlands pool has been neglected of late, however, Rondebosch are in the process of building new pools that will satisfy SA Masters' requirements.

- 7.6 Based on Neville Davies' statement above, Western Province felt that they would not like to commit to hosting next year's Masters and find out later that their new venue is not ready.
- 7.7 Two bids were considered.
 - South Western Districts to host at Knysna.
 - Border to host at East London
- 7.8 South Western Districts bid proposal
- 7.8.1 Knysna cannot control the temperature of the water and as thus it is not seen as an issue.
- 7.8.2 Development plays a key role with SWD and they would like to continue this initiative.
- 7.9 East London presented a formal request via email before the AGM to host 2008 tournament.
- 7.9.1 Neville Clarence stated that East London have gained experience from past Masters tournaments and that they have always put up a good tournament.
- 7.9.2 SA Masters is satisfied that they are capable of hosting the 2008 tournament.
- 7.9.3 Issues / Queries from Provincial representatives

Mike Renwick

- Questioned Neville Davies if alcohol would be allowed on the Rondebosch premises as this ruling prevents Gauteng from hosting the tournament at St Stithians in Randburg, Johannesburg.
- Neville responded that this should not be a problem.

Warrick Smith - Zimbabwe.

- Requested if SA Masters Swimming could be held at the same venue.
- Neville Clarence stated that SAM Swimming is independent of SA Masters Water Polo and as such were not bound by utilising the same venue and / or monthly time slot.
- 7.10 Voting.
- 7.10.1 Knysna in favour 1
- 7.10.2 East London in favour = all votes except for 1
- 7.10.3 Thus, by majority vote, the 2008 SA Masters Water Polo tournament will be hosted by Border in East London.
- 7.10.4 Tentative dates of the 2008 tournament. 21st to 23rd March 2008.
- 7.10.5 The same age groups 30+, 40+ and 50+ would be applicable in East London.

- 8.5 South Western Districts were thanked for being the hosts of the 2007 tournament.
- 8.6 Referees for the games would be nominated as follows:
- 8.6.1 Referees are to come from the water (players) ideally the previous game.
- 8.6.2 It was stated the game should be referred at the level that the game is played at not at International level but rather at Masters or club league level.
- 8.6.3 The game must be referred within the FINA rules of the game but keeping with the spirit of Masters.
- 8.6.4 The hosting province would provide referees for the first event.
- 8.7 Trophy winners see attached schedule.
