- 6.2 Request to be onboarded as a new province
 - Zambia David Chivers requested that Zambia be onboarded so that they may enter a side in future tournaments.
 - Their request was upheld without any objections.
 - Zambia to be added to the provincial representatives group.
- 6.3 Updated details of provincial representatives are attached hereto.

7. SOUTH AFRICAN MASTERS WATER POLO CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024-2025

- 7.1 Two bids were received Border and MOB (Stellenbosch).
- 7.2 Copies of the original submitted proposals attached to these minutes.
- 7.3 Many questions were raised by the representatives which remained unanswered with information contained in the available bids.
- 7.4 No vote was possible and the following process was put forward in order to reach a decision:
 - Updated bids to be received by 15h00 on Friday 31 March 2023 by email or via WhatsApp (confirm that your bid has been received).
 - Bids to be circulated via communication channels (email and SA Masters Provincial WhatsApp group) for dissemination to the respective clubs within their province by the provincial reps.
 - A single vote per province is to be submitted on the SA Masters Provincial reps WhatsApp group by 15h00 on Friday 14 April 2023.
 - The votes will be checked against the elected provincial representative and all votes submitted that do not originate from the elected representative will be voided.
 - The Execute have one (1) vote each except for the Chairman who has a casting vote in the event of tie.
 - The audited results will then be communicated via email, WhatsApp and published on the SA Masters Waterpolo website.
- 7.5 Border and MOB to provide detailed and updated bids expanding on the following:
 - Proposed dates for the 2024 and 2025 tournaments if possible incorporating the public holiday on 21 March (*Human Rights Day*) either for travelling or as a tournament game day
 - Photos of the venue especially in the case of MOB as there is mention of a new venue in Stellenbosch other than the university.
 - If the university is being considered, what are the university rules that need to be adhered to by the players?
 - Will the venue be able to accommodate three (3) swimming pools in close proximity to each other?
 - Will alcohol be permitted whilst viewing games at the pool?
 - Is there sufficient shade for the teams around the pool area?
 - Border what is the maintenance status of the Joan Harrison pool complex?

8. <u>SELECTION OF A DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE</u>

- 8.1 For any disciplinary hearing required at the tournament, the following will be required to be present:
 - Tournament directors
 - Referees involved in the game
 - Chairman of SAMWP
- 8.2 Provinces to provide suitably qualified referees to assist if called upon.

9. <u>GENERAL</u>

9.1 Team entries

9.1.1 Analysis of the 2023 entrants.

- 9.1.2 Based on the above, there is critical mass in the 40+, 50+ and 60+ age groups.
- 9.1.3 The Open and 30+ age groups are below critical mass.
- 9.1.4 In speaking with the Western Province reps, they are confident that the Open section will be sufficiently supported next year if they win the bid for the 2024 tournament.
- 9.1.5 The KZN organisers had to combine the Open and 30+ age groups for the past two tournaments to achieve critical mass to host the younger age groups.
- 9.1.6 This highlights the problem that Masters Waterpolo is experiencing in that the younger players are generally not following through into the 30+ age group.
- 9.1.7 The following was raised with Ian van Zyl during the tournament for possible consideration by the next tournament organisers to address the younger age group participation at the tournament:
- 9.1.8 Consider approaching the various university water polo clubs for participation in the event. This may create the impetus for these players to continue playing waterpolo and eventually serve as the feeder into the 30+ age group since there is a big gap between waterpolo at schools level and then again at Masters level if one has not made the provincial / national team selection. (*A recent tournament attracted 7-8 Varsity teams*)
- 9.1.9 The gentleman who raised this point is happy to sponsor the trophies for this *Varsity group* if it materialises.

9.2 <u>Games on the last day of the tournament</u>

- 9.2.1 The Local Organising Committee (LOC) to consider that all teams should get at least one (1) or two (2) games on the last day of the tournament.
- 9.2.2 No shows for games should result in the offending provinces being fined R1,000 per defaulting team for any no shows with exclusion from the next tournament if the monies are not paid over to the organising LOC.

9.3 <u>Tournament Referees</u>

- 9.3.1 The quality of referees across all age groups was brought up at the AGM under general.
- 9.3.2 There are many tournament players who are FINA qualified referees and are not being called upon to provide assistance during the tournament.
- 9.3.3 The LOC should endeavour to reach out to these player-referees for assistance during the tournament thereby ensuring that all games in all age groups will have two qualified referees calling the game.
- 9.3.4 Mr Guy Pinker, a FINA Olympic referee, has offered to donate a trophy for the best local referee (not player-referee) appointed by the LOC to encourage youngsters to take up the call of refereeing and starting their journey to possibly becoming a future Olympic referee themselves.

10. DATE OF NEXT MEETING

10.1 The date of the next Annual General Meeting will be on the Wednesday night prior to the commencement of the 2024 tournament – dates to be finalised.

11. <u>CLOSURE</u>

11.1 There being no further business to discuss the meeting closed at 19h15.
